

Judges Applicant Fact Sheet

- 1. NSBA Membership: Applicant must be a current NSBA member in good standing member for at least one year prior to the year in which you apply.
- 2. Applicant must be at least 25.
- 3. Applicant must complete and submit the NSBA Judges Application by October 1st, 2024.
- 4. Applicants names will be published prior to the Judges Committee review.
- 5. References: An applicant must have a total of six (6) references:
 - Two (2) Personal References from current NSBA members
 - Two (2) Show Management references applicant has worked for in the past
 - Two (2) Judge References from a NSBA Judge

References will be completed and returned to the NSBA office by the person who completes them. All references must be in our files prior to October 1 or the application will be considered incomplete and will not qualify for review. No member of the Judges Committee may be used for a reference. Reference forms are included with this application and also available on the NSBA website.

- 6. After the application deadline, the Judges Committee will review all completed applications. Following the Judges Committee review, applicants will be notified as to whether they have been invited to the applicant testing. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed by the Judges Committee.
 - a. If an application is denied, applicant can resubmit an application with new references immediately. A second filing fee must be paid at that time.
 - b. If an applicant is invited to the applicant school and fails to make a passing grade, he/she may reapply immediately. Reapplying will require applicants to resubmit an application and application fee (no new references).
 - c. If an applicant fails to pass the second time, an applicant must wait one year to reapply.
 - d. An individual may not re-apply for a period of five years after being denied three times for any of the following:
 - i. Denial of permission to attend a qualifying examination by Judges Committee.
 - ii. Failure to pass the qualifying exam
 - iii. Failure to obtain approval from the Judges Committee or NSBA Executive Committee, for any reason.
- 7. Approved applicants will be tested, December, 2024 in Weatherford, TX. A confirmation letter with the exact dates and times of required sessions will be sent to all approved applicants.



Applicant testing will include a current year closed rulebook test, video testing on all NSBA disciplines, video testing for Category I status (optional) and a personal interview session.

- 8. The scores earned at the judges' school will be reviewed by the Judges Committee at their next scheduled meeting. The Committee will solely determine if an applicant's qualifications approve him/her for holding NSBA judging credentials and/or Category I status. Applicants that pass the standard testing and do not pass the Category I requirement can retake the Category I at a later date.
- 9. If you are approved for judging status, your name will be added to the permanent judges list & it will be mandatory to attend a recertification session within your first year as a NSBA Judge.
- 10. NSBA application fee of \$100 and does not include the Category I application fee (separate application) and is non refundable.
